

This cause came on for hearing this day before the Court upon the pleading of the plaintiffs herein filed. John S. Mackey appeared as attorney for the plaintiffs and defendants failed to appear either in person or by an attorney. The Court has examined the pleadings herein and has examined the files and proofs and heard the testimony offered in support of the pleadings and the Court being advised in the premises does find as follows:

That each and all of the above named defendants have been duly and regularly served with Summons and process by publication in the manner and for the time required by law;

That each and all of said defendants have failed to answer the complaint filed herein by the plaintiffs and said defendants have made no appearance herein and are now in default for answer or other appearances;

That on the 19th day of March, 1932, the lands hereafter described, and the fee simple title and estate therein, were owned by the above named plaintiff, Pete Radakovich, said lands being:

The southwest quarter (SW¹/₄) of Section Twenty-three (23);
Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range One Hundred Eight (108)
West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, Wyoming;

and on said date Pete Radakovich, joined by his wife, Eva Radakovich, plaintiff herein, delivered unto Victor Tadevic, defendant herein, their jointly executed mortgage deed covering the lands aforesaid as security for payment of a certain indebtedness owing by Pete Radakovich to Victor Tadevic in the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, said indebtedness being evidenced by one promissory note under date of March 19th, 1932, and payable by Pete Radakovich in the amount
