RIGHT-OF-WAY

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged C. M. BRAWLEY and MARJORIE BRAWLEY, his wife, GRANTORS, do hereby for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, grant and release to MOUNTAIN FUEL SUPPLY COMPANY a Corporation of the State of Utah, GRANTEE, its successors and assigns a right of way and easement fifty (50) feet in width to construct and maintain a road over and through the following described lands, to-wit:

T. 28 N., R. 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ W., 6th P.M., Wyoming, Sublette County
Sec. 35: SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$

including the waiver and release of the right of homestead with the right of ingress and egress to and from the same if such is necessary.

Mountain Fuel Supply Company to install or cause to be installed cattle guards in any fence the road may intersect.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said MOUNTAIN FUEL SUPPLY COMPANY, its successors and assigns so long as the road shall be maintained.

Should Mountain Fuel elect to abandon such road at a later date, it will remove cattle guards and restore the fences to their original condition and will also remove any culvert or culverts installed in the construction of such road.

The said Grantors to fully use the said premises except for the purposes for which this right of way and easement is granted to the said Grantee provided such does not interfere with the road construction by the Grantee or any other rights granted to the Grantee hereunder.
