John R. Smith, executor of the Estate of Allene J. Graham, also known as Allene Jay Graham, also known as Allene Graham, deceased, having heretofore rendered and filed herein his amended full account and report of his administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed an amended petition for the distribution of said estate; and said account and petition this day coming regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that notice of settlement of said final account and the hearing of said petition has been given in the manner and for the time in such cases required by law; and the Court, being fully advised in the premises, finds:

1. That said account is in all respects a true, full and correct account, and that all claims and debts against said decedent, all taxes against said estate, and all debts, expenses and charges of administration, except those items hereinafter specifically set forth, have been fully paid and discharged, and that said estate is now ready for distribution and in a condition to be closed.

2. That the executor, John R. Smith, and his attorney, Robert L. Bath have rendered and performed services for and in connection with said estate for which they are entitled to compensation as provided by law.

3. That the residue of money in the hands of the executor after payment of the statutory commissions to said executor and his attorney with other final costs of administration as set out in said account is \$21,416.21. In addition to said proceeds the mineral interest in certain lands, hereinafter particularly described, remains for distribution according to the terms of the last will and testament of said decedent.

4. That the whole of said estate was the separate property of said decedent.

5. That under the terms of the last will and testament of said decedent, which was duly admitted to probate herein on the 2nd day of May, 1958, said deceased devised and bequeathed her whole estate following a bequest in the sum of \$1,000.00 to the Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children of San Francisco, California, which was paid to said hospital by the California executor, Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association, in the domiciliary administration before the Superior Court in and for the city and county of San Francisco, state of California, who likewise delivered the jewelry, clothing and other personal effects to Mrs. Grace P. Adams of Fort Myer, Florida according to the terms of said will, to the persons and in the proportions in said will as hereinafter decreed.
