BILL OF SALE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, David C. Bintliff, a citizen and resident of the State of Texas, in consideration of \$10.00 and other good and valuable consideration to me in hand paid by Belco Petroleum Corporation, a Delaware Corporation, and other valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, transferred and delivered and by these presents do bargain, sell, grant, convey, transfer and deliver unto the said Belco Petroleum Corporation, the following:

- 1) All my interest in all tubing, casing, well-head equipment, field separators, lease tanks, and all other equipment attached to any and all gas and oil wells located on properties and interests set forth as belonging jointly to said Belco Petroleum Corporation (Predecessor Corporation) and David C. Bintliff and listed in Exhibit A to an Agreement dated as of June 22, 1959 between the stockholders of Belco Petroleum Corporation (Predecessor Corporation), the partners of Belfer Natural Gas Company, and David C. Bintliff, such properties and interests being all of the oil and gas properties and interests owned by me in Sublette County, Wyoming;
- 2) All my interest in the low pressure field gathering, dehydration and compressor facilities located on the aforementioned properties and interests;
- 3) All my interest in the main compressor station #23, located in the Big Piney field, Wyoming, including piping, lubrication oil system, engines, cooling tanks, and such other similar and related machinery, equipment and facilities appropriate or necessary for the efficient operation of said compressor station, all as more particularly described in drawings and specifications set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" and "C" of the Agreement dated August 10, 1955 between Belco Petroleum Corporation, David C. Bintliff and Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation, and superchargers, two 880 horsepower compressors and appurtenant facilities thereto all installed subsequent to the Agreement of August 10, 1955,
