

That on the 4th day of June, 1959, said Executor returned to this Court an inventory of all property belonging to the said decedent's estate and which had come and was then under the possession and control of said Executor, together with an appraisal thereof was required by law;

That pursuant to the Last Will and Testament of said decedent, admitted to probate as aforesaid, the premises and real property described as Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block Five (5) of Patterson's First Addition to the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming, was devised in equal shares unto Glenna Angrid Anderson and James Laurence Anderson, that said devisees are minor persons, and residents of the State of Utah, and having no general guardian, and that Robert W.
