

has filed herein his report approving said account and waiving the hearing thereon and notice of the time and place thereof, and agreeing that the accounting for rents received by the Executor from said property, less expenses chargeable thereto, in amount of \$860.39 be set over to said minor children, and it appearing to the Court that the accounting of rents received as aforesaid is true and correct and disbursements therefrom are supported by vouchers, said sum above shown is correct and should be set over to said minor children equal shares, together with the aforesaid real estate;

That the Executor, Frederick Laurence Eklund, is indebted to the estate in amount of \$1,888.72, as evidenced by his promissory note dated December 4, 1959, and payable to himself as said Executor, for withdrawals by him, and that Lot Seven (7) in Block Six (6) of the Hennick Second Addition to the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming, was devised by the decedent's Will unto Frederick Laurence Eklund, and that during the administration of the within estate said Executor has received from said property as net rental income, the sum of \$566.88, that said real estate and net income should be set over unto Frederick Laurence Eklund, except that the same should be accomplished as to said money by allowing credit upon the aforesaid promissory note in amount of \$566.88, it appearing to the Court that the accounting for said rental income is true and complete and disbursements therefrom are supported by proper vouchers and cancelled checks;

That at the time of filing said Final Account said Executor had on hand a balance of cash in amount of \$1,343 35, and that subsequent thereto and on the 4th day of January, 1960 said Executor and Dorothy Eklund Anderson did borrow the sum of \$5,000.00 from the State Bank of Big Piney, Wyoming, and give in evidence thereof their promissory note bearing date of January 4, 1960, and payable according to the terms thereof, and that said sum was contributed to the Executor's account for use in discharging and paying further expenses and obligations of the estate and more specifically the sum of \$2,500 00 owing to said State Bank of Big Piney, Wyoming for loan made November 19, 1959, together with interest accrued to date of January 4, 1960, in amount of \$18.75 was paid in full on said date, and there has been additional income to the estate since the filing of said Final Account in amount of \$17 93, leaving a cash blance on hand on the date hereof in amount of \$3,842 53, and that no disbursements other than above have been made since the rendition of said account;
