Capitola Looney Bond, the surviving widow of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, having filed herein her petition praying that all of the property belonging to the estate of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, be set over to her as her absolute property, exempt from attachment and execution for debts, obligations and contracts incurred by Vernon L. Looney, deceased, during his lifetime, and subject as security for the payment of \$4000.00, and subject further to the payment of expenses incurred in the administration of the estate of Vernon L. Looney, deceased; and it appearing to the court that:
Vernon L. Looney died on the 4th day of December, 1952, and being at the time of his death a resident of Sublette County, State of Wyoming, leaving him surviving his widow, the said Capitola Looney Bond, and his two sons, Vernon L. Looney, Jr. and Robert C. Looney, each of whom is over the age of 21 years; that Capitola Looney Bond was appointed Administratrix of the estate of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, on the 5th day of March, 1953, and that Letters of Administration were issued to Capitola Looney Bond on the 13th day of April, 1953, and have not been revoked; that on the 15th day of July, 1954, said Administratrix made first publication of Notice to Creditors of said decedent; and that said Administratrix has made publication of this Court's Order to Show Cause upon the petition of Capitola Looney Bond to set over exempt property and of the time and place for hearing upon said petition by the Court, according to law; that on the 17th day of July, 1954, said Administratrix returned into this Court an Inventory and Appraisement of the property contained in said decedent's estate in which the value of all property belonging to said estate was appraised at the sum of \$3,000.00;
That no claims incurred by way of last illness or for funeral expense have been filed in this Court against the decedent's estate and all expenses of administration have been paid and satisfied;
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all of the property belonging to the estate of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, be, and the same is hereby set over and distributed to Capitola Looney Bond, the surviving widow of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, and to her heirs and assigns forever, and exempt from attachment and execution upon account of any debts, contracts and obligations incurred by the decedent in his life time, and subject only to that certain real estate mortgage in the sum of \$4000.00 in favor of the Jackson State Bank of Jackson, Wyoming.

The following is a description of all property contained in the estate of Vernon L. Looney, deceased, and hereby set over to Capitola Looney Bond, as the surviving widow of said deceased, to-wit:
Lots 3, 4 and 5, in Block 8, of the C. P. MacGlashan First Addition to the Town of Big Piney, Wyoming.
Dabin in the Bridger National Forest on Special Use Permit.
