GRANT OF EASEMENT

V. L. Looney and Patricia E. Looney, husband and wife, of Sublette County, Wyoming, for and in consideration of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable considerations have granted and conveyed and do hereby grant and convey unto Frederick W. Jackson and Frances Trotter Jackson, husband and wife, of Sublette County, Wyoming, a permanent easement and right-of-way for the following purposes, namely;

The right to enter upon the hereinafter described lands and grade and level, fill, drain, pave, build, maintain, repair and re-build a road or highway, together with such bridges, culverts, ramps and cuts as maybe necessary on and across the lands embraced within the right-of-way, hereinafter described, which is located within the boundaries of a tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming and described as Lot Two (2) of Section Three (3), Township 33 North, Range 109 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian.

The easement and right-of-way herein granted covers a strip of land 40 feet in width across the above described lands and is more particularly located and described as being 20 feet on each side of a center line, the beginning or initial point whereof lies 70 feet N 89° 50' W of the Northeast corner of the aforesaid Lot 2, and which line thence bears S 0° 12' E for a distance of 1254 feet, more or less, to the East West Center line of the aforesaid Section 3.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the easement and right-of-way unto the said Frederick W. Jackson and Frances Trotter Jackson, husband and wife and their heirs and assigns forever and to be appurtenant to and for the benefit of lands owned by the said Frederick W. Jackson and Frances Trotter Jackson lying and situate in Lots One (1) and Two (2) of the aforesaid Section Three (3), Township 33 North, Range 109 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian.
