

10. That the total amount to date due and owing to the Lienor from said Homer Wilder is \$1,481.91.

11. That on the 15th day of November, 1960, Homer Wilder was given written notice by the Lienor that the within Lien Account would be filed within the time prescribed by statute unless the sum of \$1,481.91 as aforesaid was paid to said Lienor within 10 days after his receipt of said notice.

12. That Homer Wilder did not within said 10 day period pay said account.

13. You are hereby respectfully requested to do the following:

(a) To endorse upon the within Lien Account its date of filing.

(b) To index said Lien Account in your Abstract of Liens, noting therein that John North, an individual d/b/a John North Hardware & Lumber, claims a lien upon the property and rights, titles and interests belonging to Homer Wilder, as aforesaid, to the extent of \$1,481.91.

(c) And to do all other things required to be done by you according to law to duly file and register the within Lien Account.
