equipment, and all business connected with or incidental thereto.

3. To engage in the business of fire fighting, aerial surveying and photography, and in the carriage and transportation of personnel, equipment, tools, and instruments for the doing of any such activities.

4. To construct, build, manufacture, repair, rebuild, and refurbish airplanes, including all classes of flying machines and their component parts and accessories; to buy, sell, lease, hire, import, export and otherwise deal therein; and to operate, or have operated, such machines for any and all lawful purposes whatsoever, including the use thereof in rescue work, air demonstrations, and circuses, and in the teaching, training and instruction of aviation and navigation, and in the repair and maintenance of airplanes and their component parts and accessories.

Clause (b). Ancillary Purposes. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes hereinabove set forth, and to do all other things incidental thereto or connected therewith, which are not forbidden by the Statutes, by other law, or by these Articles of Incorporation.

Clause (c). To Carry out Such Purposes in Other States. To carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign country, to the extent that such purposes are not forbidden by the law of such state, territory, district, or possession of the United States or by such foreign country.

Section 2. Statutory Powers. The Corporation shall have all the rights and benefits with the correlative duties and burdens provided under the corporate laws of the State of
