GRANT OR EASEMENT FOR NATURAL GAS PIPE LINE

TO

EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Wyoming, acting within the authority vested in it by and under the Constitution of the State of Wyoming and the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, doth, for and in consideration of the payment of TWENTY-FIVE AND 00/100 DOLLARS

(\$ 25.00) grant to EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY

for the uses and purposes and upon the conditions hereinafter set forth, an easement for NATURAL GAS PIPE LINE over a certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land for a Natural Gas Pipe Line Seventy-five feet (75') in width across the Southeast Quarter Southwest Quarter ($\text{SE}^{\frac{1}{4}}\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$) Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twenty-eight (28) North, Range One Hundred Thirteen (113) West of the 6th P. M. in Sublette County, Wyoming, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southern boundary of said Section 36 and on the northern boundary of Section 1, Township 27 North, Range 113 West, 6th P. M., which point bears in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of said Section 1, distant 2427.6 feet from the Northwest corner of said Section 1; thence North 34° 34' East a distance of 1022.4 feet; thence North 10° 05' East a distance of 157.0 feet; thence North 01° 07' East a distance of 106.0 feet; thence North 36° 07' East a distance of 99.2 feet; thence North 26° 30' East a distance of 175.6 feet to the end of the line.
