

And the Court having examined the files and records herein, and having heard the testimony offered in support of the Complaint, and being advised in the premises finds the allegations of the Complaint are true as stated, and that relief demanded in said Complaint should be granted;

Now, upon the motion of John S. Mackey, Plaintiffs' attorney, as aforesaid, the Court does order, adjudge and decree:

1.

That the Plaintiffs, Donald R. Wassenberg and June L. Wassenberg, were at all times mentioned herein and are now the owners in fee simple and entitled to the exclusive possession and enjoyment of the following described premises and real property to wit: Lots three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), and seven (7) in Block 33 of the Marbleton Townsite, Sublette County, Wyoming, together with the buildings and improvements situate thereon or appurtenant thereto;

2.

That the claims of the Defendants, Dan H. Budd, Dorothy B. Newcomb, Jennie B. Jordan, the Marbleton Townsite Company, a corporation, and Dan H. Budd, Administrator of the estate of Charles P. Budd, deceased, and all persons who claim title under them, in and to the aforesaid real property are without any right whatsoever, and that said Defendants have no right, title, interest, claim or estate whatsoever in or upon said premises and real property or any part thereof, and said Defendants and all persons claiming under them are hereby enjoined and debarred from claiming or asserting any estate, right, title, interest in or claim or lien upon said real property and premises or any part thereof.
