Arambel, as aforesaid, and that said Dunton Sheep Company, a Wyoming corporation, as such assignee, is entitled to have set over and decreed to it the nineteen (19) shares of the capital stock of Dunton Sheep Company which were bequeathed to said Robert P. Arambel, as aforesaid;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the said final account of said executor in the matter of each of said estates be, and the same is hereby, settled, allowed and approved, and that the residue of the estate of said John Arambel, deceased, and the residue of the estate of said Lucie Arambel, deceased, hereinbefore particularly described, and any other property not now known or discovered and which may belong to said estates, or in which either of said estates may have any interest, be, and the same is hereby, distributed, paid, delivered, granted, conveyed and set over as follows:

To said Rosemary Arambel, daughter of decedents, to have and to hold the same unto herself, her heirs and assigns forever:

All of that certain lot, tract or parcel of land situate in the City of Rock Springs, County of Sweetwater and State of Wyoming, which is particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point Three Hundred Forty-Five and One-Tenth (345.1) feet east and Two Hundred Fourteen (214) feet south of the Northwest Corner of Section Thirty-Six (36), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range One Hundred Five (105), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian; thence south Forty (40) feet; thence east One Hundred Fifty (150) feet; thence north Forty (40) feet; thence west One Hundred Fifty (150) feet, to the point of beginning, now also described as Lot numbered Five (5), in Block numbered Six (6), in the Central Coal and Coke Company's First Addition to Rock Springs, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, together with all improvements thereon and all easements and appurtenances belonging or appertaining thereto;
