11. That Helen E. Bray, widow of the decedent, over the age of 21 years, Big Piney, Wyoming; Frank B. Bray, Jr., Big Piney, Wyoming, over the age of 21 years and Gordon Bray, Big Piney, Wyoming over the age of 21 years, are the surviving heirs at law and next of kin of the decedent. That your Executrix is the sole beneficiary under the terms of the decedent's Will; that Frank B. Bray, Jr. and Gordon Bray have signed a waiver of the requirement for a notice of the publication of the time when your Executrix's Final Account would be heard and an order of the distribution entered.

12. That the heirs at law and next of kin of the decedent were each duly notified of the time of filing of Executrix's Final Account and Petition for Distribution. That no objections have been filed by anyone to the Final Account filed by said Executrix, and the time within which objections could be filed has expired.

13. That no inheritance tax is due the State of Wyoming from said estate and a receipt has been duly issued by the inheritance tax commissioner showing no tax due. That no inheritance tax is due the United States Government from said estate.
