That the foregoing restrictive covenants shall be made a part of any future conveyance of all the parties hereto, their heirs and assigns and all subsequent transfers of title shall be subject to the conditions and restrictions herein before mentioned which are common to all lots in the subdivision.

If any person or persons shall at any time violate or attempt to violate or shall omit to perform or observe any one of the foregoing restrictions or conditions it shall be lawful for any person owning a lot in the Ball Subdivision, herein before specifically described, all of which are subject to said restrictions and conditions, to which the default is made, to institute and prosecute appropriate proceedings at law or equity for the wrong done or attempted.

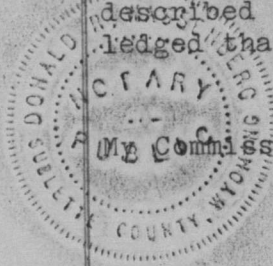
