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jurisdiction to hear said report and make and enter a decree of final distribution of said estate as the facts may warrant. Evidence having been adduced in support of said Petition and the matter being submitted to the Court and the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds generally that the Report should be approved and the prayer of said Petition be granted.

THE COURT DOTH FURTHER FIND that on the 18th day of April, 1962, George J. Peters died intestate in Goshen County, Wyoming, of which place he was a resident and was possessed of an estate in Goshen County, Wyoming.

THE COURT DOTH FURTHER FIND that this Administratrix was appointed as such on the 29th day of May, 1962, and qualified as such Administratrix on the 29th day of May, 1962, by filing a bond as provided by order of this Court and taking the oath in such cases made and provided, according to law, and is now the duly appointed, qualified and acting Administratrix of said estate.

THE COURT DOTH FURTHER FIND that under the date of May 29, 1962, said Administratrix gave notice of her appointment to creditors and all persons interested in said estate, requiring creditors to file their claims as provided by law, and said Notice was in due form and published as required by law, in the Torrington Telegram, above referred to, and said Notice appeared in each of the issues of said paper of May 31, June 7 and 14, 1962; and the time has elapsed and expired in which creditors may file their claims against said estate.

THE COURT DOTH FURTHER FIND that this Administratrix has caused an Inventory and Appraisement of this estate to be filed in this Court on the property in said estate which set forth said property owned by deceased, as provided by law, and the value thereof; the total value of the property in the estate being the sum of \$19,935.00.

THE COURT DOTH FURTHER FIND that this Administratrix, since the time of her appointment to the date of making her Final Report and Petition for Distribution, received the following moneys, to-wit:
