DECREE DETERMINING HEIRS AND HEIRSHIP

THIS MATTER, coming on regularly to be heard upon the application and petition filed herein by Louise A. Craft of Rock Springs, Wyoming, and it appearing to the Court that notice of the hearing on said application and petition was published and given in the manner and for the time in such cases required by law, and in accordance with the Order Fixing Time and Place of Hearing, heretofore made and entered herein; that no one has appeared to object to, or contest, said petition, and that no objections have been filed thereto; and that no one has made or filed any claim in this matter, or to the hereinafter particularly described real property;

And the Court, after hearing the evidence offered in support of said application and petition, and being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

That the above-named Jennie B. Larson died intestate at Rock Springs, in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, on the 27th day of May, 1941;

That at the time of her death, said Jennie B. Larson was a resident of Rock Springs, in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, and was the owner and seized of the following described real property, situated in Sublette County, Wyoming:

An undivided one-eighth interest in and to the North Half of the Southwest Quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}$), Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$) Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range One Hundred Ten (110), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, together with all improvements thereon and all appurtenances belonging or appertaining thereto, including but without thereby limiting the generality of the foregoing, all water and water rights, ditches and ditch rights, reservoirs and reservoir rights, and the rights to the use of all water, ditches and reservoirs used in connection with or appertaining to said lands;

That the interest and title of said Jennie B. Larson in and to the above described real property was derived as follows: That upon the death of one Charles Hedin, intestate, on October 1, 1908, in Uinta County, Wyoming, he was the owner of all of the above described real property, and that he left surviving him, as his sole and only heir at law, his brother, Nels P. Anderson; that said Nels P. Anderson died, intestate, at Rock Springs, Wyoming, on the 15th day of June, 1918, leaving the following surviving him as his only heirs at law: Ingrid B. Anderson, widow, Agnes M. Gottschalk, daughter, Elmer N. Anderson, son, Arthur B. Anderson, son, and said Jennie B. Larson, daughter;
