All transmission and distribution lines, together with necessary appurtenances thereon, transformers, meters, franchises, easements and right of way agreements of every kind and nature, presently owned by party of the first part in its business of an electric utility.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever. And party of the first part does covenant and agree to and with said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, to WARRANT AND DEFEND the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, against all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

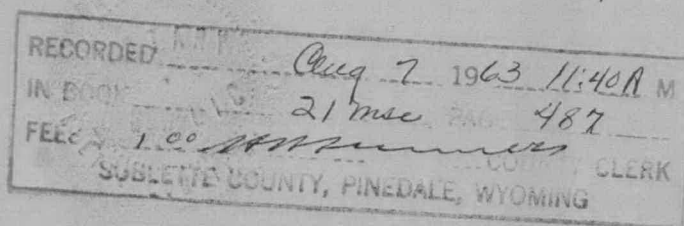
