

John A. Spicer, son of decedent, aged over twenty-one years, residing at 352 South Lorraine Avenue, Glendora, California;

And it further appearing that in and by his said last will and testament, admitted to probate herein on the 5th day of May, 1961, said Ernest Spicer, now deceased, gave, devised and bequeathed all of his estate as follows:

"FIRST: I first direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after the time of my decease.

SECOND: If my wife, Ruth Spicer, survives me for a period of thirty (30) days after my death, that is to say, if she is living at the expiration of a period of thirty (30) days after my death, then and in that event, I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Ruth Spicer, all the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated."

And it further appearing that, under the terms and provisions of said last will and testament, said Ruth Spicer, widow of decedent, is entitled to all of the residue and remainder of said estate;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the final account of said executrix be, and the same is hereby, settled, allowed and approved, and that the residue of said estate, hereinbefore particularly described, and any other property not now known or discovered, and which may belong to said estate, or in which said estate may have any interest, be, and the same is hereby, distributed, granted, conveyed and set over as follows:

To said Ruth Spicer, widow of decedent, and sole legatee and devisee under the terms and provisions of said last will and testament, all of the residue and remainder of said estate, to have and to hold the same unto herself, her heirs and assigns forever.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECREED that said executrix, upon payment, transfer and delivery of said residue, as hereinbefore ordered, and upon filing a proper receipt therefor in this Court, shall be entitled to be fully and finally released and discharged from her trust as such executrix.
