A F F I D A V I T

Walter W. Lozier, being first duly sworn upon his oath according to law, deposes and says:

That he is of the age of forty nine years and has been a resident of the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming throughout the full term of his life; that Irvin M. Lozier was his father and Lizzie Lozier was his mother; and that Irvin M. Lozier, sometimes known as I. M. Lozier and Irvin M. Lozier, is deceased, and that he died on the 12th day of January, 1943; and, further, that Lizzie Lozier, his mother, is deceased, and that she died on the 23rd day of December, 1961;

That Irvin M. Lozier and Lizzie Lozier were resident of the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming at the time of their respective deaths, and, further, that each of them died intestate;

That the surviving heirs at law and all of the surviving heirs at law of the Irvin M. Lozier, deceased, and Lizzie Lozier, deceased, are their four sons whose names are: Robert George Lozier, Roy Ward Lozier, Earl Hezekiah Lozier, and Walter W. Lozier, this affiant, each of whom is over the age of twenty one years;

That by operation of law the above named heirs at law of the Irvin M. Lozier, deceased, and Lizzie Lozier, deceased, has succeeded to all of the right, title, interest, estate and equity held by the Irvin M. Lozier and Lizzie Lozier at the time of their respective deaths in and to the following described lands situate in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, to-wit:
