

Murphy, is a like sum, plus costs and administrative expenses paid and incurred by them in the amount of \$72.48.

6. The decedent's December 18, 1960 Will made certain specific

bequests to relatives of the decedent and the executor certifies that all of such bequests were duly carried out and that all personal property mentioned in said Will has been delivered to the beneficiaries named therein. The said Will further directs that the entire residue of the Estate remaining after delivery of the said bequests shall go to petitioner as surviving husband of the decedent, and all of such property should be set over and distributed to the petitioner as residuary beneficiary under the decedent's said Will.

7. The estate is now in condition for closing, the actions and accountings

of the executor are in all respects true, correct and proper and should be approved and confirmed.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the

executor be, and he is hereby authorized to pay his attorneys' fee in the amount of

\$101.31, plus their costs and administration expenses amounting to \$72.48; that decedent's

one-third (1/3) mineral interest in and to the following described lands in Sublette

County, Wyoming be, and it is hereby set over and distributed to John H. Schmitz:

Lot 1, S½NE¼, N½SE¼, Section 20, Lots 4 and 9, SW¼NW¼, Section 21, Township 30 North, Range 110 West of the 6th P.M., Sublette County, Wyoming, containing 308.29 acres, more or less, subject to the reservations and provisions contained in that certain mineral Quitclaim Deed dated July 31, 1961 and recorded August 2, 1961 in Book 3 of Quitclaim Deeds, page 327 in the records of Sublette County, Wyoming;

and that the entire estate then be set over and distributed to the heirs at law of the

decedent; and, that upon a showing by the executor that he has complied with all of the

terms of this Order, the estate shall be finally closed and the executor discharged and

released of further responsibility herein.
