I, Paul N. Scherbel of Big Piney, Wyoming hereby certify that this map was made from notes taken during an actual survey supervised by me and made by Richard C. Leonard during October, 1964 and that it correctly represents the SHRIVER SUBDIVISION of parts of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, T34N, R109W, Sublette County, Wyoming as marked on the ground during said survey and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point of tangency of curvature on the Southerly right-of-way of the Cora-Pinedale County Road, thence N39°46'W, 312.1 ft. along said right-of-way to a point; thence N39°46'W, 516.5 ft. along said right-of-way to a point; thence N39°46'W, 959.5 ft. along said right-of-way to a point; thence S50°09'W, 288.3 ft. to a point; thence S19°01'E, 689.6 ft. to a point; thence S41°14'E, 314.7 ft. to a point which bears N75°57'E, 1335.8 ft. from the West one-quarter corner of Section 29, T34N, R109W; thence S70°36'E, 319.0 ft. to a point; thence S32°51'E, 550.0 ft. to a point; thence S01°29'E, 653.4 ft. to a point; thence S78°34'E, 152.3 ft. to a point; thence S01°10'E, 220.8 ft. to a point; thence S78°34'E, 549.3 ft. to a point on the Westerly right-of-way line of the Cora-Pinedale County Road; thence N01°04'W, 287.6 ft. along said right-of-way to a point of curvature to the North and West; thence around said curve, along said right-of-way line 272.5 ft., more or less, through an angle of 09°46' to the left to a point, which point bears S07°44'W, 693.7 ft. from the center 1/4 corner of Section 29, T34N, R109W; thence continuing along said right-of-way line 414.7 ft., more or less, through an angle of 14°54' to the left to a point; thence continuing along said right-of-way line 183.0 ft. more or less, through an angle of 06°34' to the left to a point; thence continuing along said right-of-way 208.2 ft., more or less, through an angle of 07°28' to the left to the point of beginning; containing an area of 32.31 acres, more or less, each point being marked by a steel T-shaped stake with brass cap inscribed "SURVEY POINT DO NOT DISTURB RLS 164", and subject to an easement for electrical power line granted to the Lincoln Service Corporation of record in the Office of the Clerk of Sublette County in Book 21 of Miscellaneous on page 547.

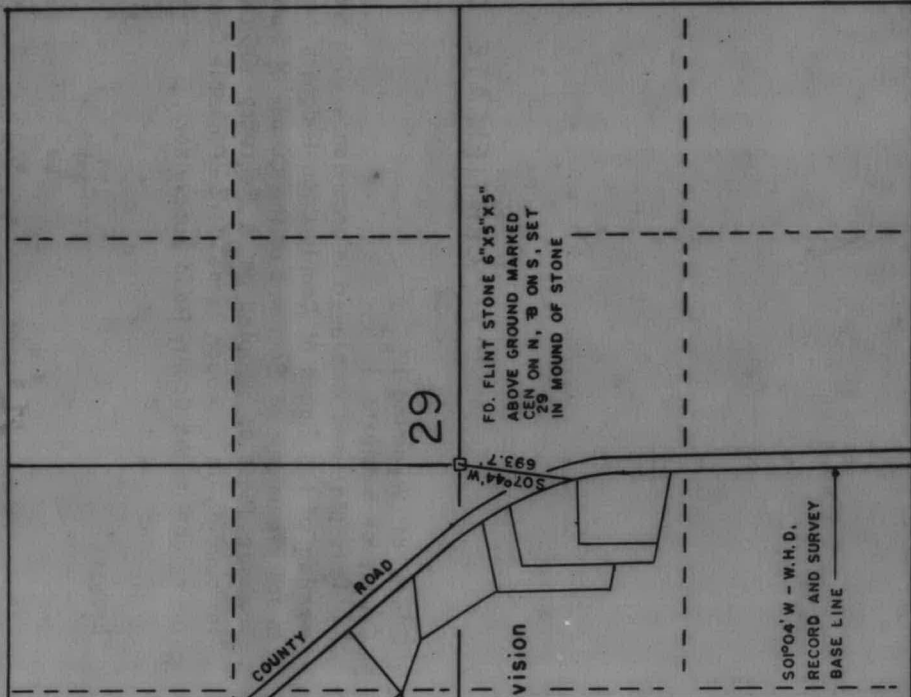
