

left real and personal property therein subject to the jurisdiction of this Court.

2. That Priscilla B. Baker was appointed administratrix of decedent's estate on May 14, 1964, and, having qualified as such, Letters of Administration issued to her on May 25, 1964; that Priscilla B. Baker has been and is now the duly qualified, appointed and acting executrix of the estate of said decedent.

3. That Notice to Creditors was published in the form and for the times prescribed by statute; that the first publication thereof appeared on May 28, 1964, and the time within which creditors could file claims against this estate accordingly expired on November 29, 1964; that all claims filed in these proceedings and all debts of decedent have been paid; that an Inventory and Appraisement of this estate was herein made and returned as required by law and within the time limited therefor.

4. That all notices required by law and pertaining to the administration of this estate have been timely and properly given and published in all respects as by statute required.

5. That the Final Account filed herein by said administratrix is in all things true and correct, and all disbursements therein disclosed, and all of the acts of said administratrix with respect to the administration of this estate therein reported and accounted for should be confirmed and approved; that the assets of this estate on the date of decedent's death consisted of the following described real property, to-wit:
