That this affidavit concerns the following described real estate and premises, to-wit:

That the foregoing real estate and premises were conveyed to James Jorgensen and Dorthean Jorgensen, husband and wife, on the date of June 26, 1946, by means of warranty deed executed on said date by Adeline Ingalls and George Ingalls, her husband, which said deed is a matter of public record in the office of the Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, having been filed in said office on the 29th day of June, 1946, at 11:00 o'clock A. M. as instrument number 34275, and recorded in Book 5 of Deed Records, at page 5;

That at the time the aforesaid real estate and premises were conveyed unto James Jorgensen and Dorthean Jorgensen, as grantees, the said James Jorgensen and Dorthean Jorgensen were husband and wife, and said real estate and premises and the title thereto did vest in James Jorgensen and Dorthean Jorgensen, as tenants by the entirety;
