

SALES CONTRACT FOR PERMANENT
PUBLIC FISHING EASEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT of the 10 day of November, 1965, 279

by and between Ward D. Blackmon and Jessie Cox Blackmon, husband and wife, of Post Office Box 5, Town of Daniel, County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as parties of the First Part and the State of Wyoming, Wyoming Game and Fish Commission, hereinafter referred to as party of the Second Part.

WHEREAS the parties of the First Part desire to sell and the party of the Second Part desires to purchase a permanent public fishing easement, together with other rights on the lands hereinafter described:

NOW, THEREFORE, in and for the consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by both the parties of the First Part and the party of the Second Part, it is agreed as follows:

1. The First Parties agree:

- a. To sell to the party of the Second Part a permanent public fishing easement in and to the Green River insofar as it traverses the following described lands, along the east bank of said Green River where owned by the parties of the First Part along both the east and west banks of the said Green River where owned by the said parties of the First Part, to-wit:

Township 34 North Range 111 West of the 6th P.M.,
Sublette County, Wyoming.

Township 35 North Range 111 West of the 6th P.M.,
Sublette County, Wyoming.

Section 32: S $\frac{1}{2}$

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
