dition of the Bureau of Land Management within the following described area:

In Township 30 North, Range 104 West of the 6th Principal Meridian:

Sections 13, 24 and 25

for the purpose of getting said sheep to and from the aforesaid Forest Permit on the Bridger National Forest.

It is agreed that:

1. The permittee shall trail said sheep across said land in a regular and proper manner, without unnecessary delay, and within a period of time not to exceed five hours.
2. The permittee shall close all gates opened for the purpose of trailing said sheep.
3. It is expressly made a condition of this easement that if the permittee, his heirs, devisees or assigns shall abandon the use of the premises above-described for the purposes hereinabove granted, then in that event all the rights herein granted shall cease and determine and the title of the land hereinabove described shall be relieved of the burden of this easement and it is further agreed that non-user of the easement hereby granted for a period of two (2) consecutive years shall be deemed an abandonment of said use.
4. The terms, conditions and provisions hereof shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, devisees, executors, administrator, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
