THIS INDENTURE, made this 21st day of March, 1966,  
between Ralph Allen Steele, also known as Ralph A. Steele, and Irene J.  
Steele, husband and wife, of Box 506, Pinedale, Wyoming, grantors, and the  
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Washington, D. C., grantee: 22°35'00" West

WITNESSETH:

That the grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred  
Twenty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$125.00) to them in hand paid by the  
grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents  
bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said grantee, and its assigns,

A perpetual and assignable easement and right of way to locate,  
construct, operate, maintain, repair, patrol and remove utilities for a  
sanitary sewer system in, upon, over and across Tract 112E-1, reserving,  
however, to the grantors, their heirs, executors, administrators and  
assigns all right, title, interest and privilege as may be exercised and  
enjoyed without interference with or abridgment of the easement and rights  
hereby granted for said public use,

Tract 112E-1

A tract of land situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, Township  
32 North, Range 107 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sublette  
County, Wyoming, more particularly described as follows: Commencing  
at the East quarter corner of said Section 9; thence South 44°17'00"  
West for a distance of 2,054.30 feet; thence South 22°35'00" West  
for a distance of 150.00 feet; thence North 67°25'00" West for a  
distance of 225.00 feet to the point of beginning of said tract of  
land to be described; thence South 22°35'00" West for a distance of  
135.00 feet; thence South 67°25'00" East for a distance of 20.00 feet;  
thence South 22°35'00" West for a distance of 80.00 feet; thence  
North 67°25'00" West for a distance of 60.00 feet; thence North  
22°35'00" East for a distance of 80.00 feet; thence South 67°25'00"  
East for a distance of 20.00 feet; thence North 22°35'00" East for  
a distance of 135.00 feet; thence South 67°25'00" East for a  
distance of 20.00 feet to the point of beginning. The tract of  
land herein described contains 0.17 of an acre, more or less.
