5. That since the filing of said Final Account and Petition for Distribution herein, the sum of \$150.00 remains due and unpaid to Galicich and Hamm for administrative costs and expenses advanced by them, and for estimated administrative costs and expenses to be advanced by them, as attorneys for said executor.

6. That the executor and his attorneys have rendered and performed services for and in connection with said estate for which they are entitled to compensation as provided by law, and that said executor has waived any and all rights and claims he may have to compensation in excess of the sum of \$2,300.00 for services performed by him as said executor; and that said executor and attorney fees have this day been set and fixed by separate order of this Court.

7. That said Louis Charley Nelson, also known as Louis C. Nelson and L. C. Nelson, deceased, left Bennie S. Andrien, also known as Bennie Andren, his sister, Myrtle Hjerleid, his niece, and Winthrop T. Nelson and Julius Edward Nelson, his nephews, surviving him as his only heirs at law.

8. That the Last Will and Testament of Louis Charley Nelson, deceased, admitted to probate herein, provides as follows:

"SECOND: I hereby give, devise and bequeath to Mary Nelson, my wife, an undivided one-half interest in and to all of the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to have and to hold unto herself, her heirs and assigns forever.

THIRD: I give and bequeath to Bennie Andren, my sister, the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, to have and to hold unto herself, her heirs and assigns forever.

FOURTH: I give and bequeath to Myrtle Hjerleid, my niece,
