DECREE OF SETTLEMENT OF FINAL ACCOUNT AND DISTRIBUTION

Hugh M. Reed, as executor of the Last Will and Testament of Joseph Huston, deceased, having on or before the 14th day of Oct. 1966, rendered and filed in the above entitled Court and proceeding a full and true account and report of his administration of the estate of said decedent, which account is for a final settlement, and having filed therewith a petition for distribution of said estate, and said account and report and petition coming on regularly for hearing before the Court, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that due and legal notice thereof had been given to the creditors and other persons interested in said estate in the manner and substance required by law, by publication of notice in the Pinedale Roundup, a weekly newspaper regularly printed and published at Pinedale, Sublette County, and State of Wyoming, and of general circulation, for four successive weeks, commencing with its issue of October 13, 1966, and waiver of notice of time and place of hearing of said Final Account and Petition for Distribution having been filed herein by Orvene Reed, the only heir in Sublette County.

There being no one appearing in opposition or objecting thereto, and it appearing of record herein that by an order of this Court made and entered herein on the 30th day of April, 1964, the Last Will and Testament of said decedent was admitted to probate and Hugh M. Reed was appointed and qualified as executor thereof and Letters Testamentary issued to him by the Clerk of this Court on said date and he thereupon gave notice to the creditors of said deceased in the manner and substance provided by law to present to him or file with the Clerk of said Court their claims within six months from May 27, 1965, the date of the first publication of said notice, which notice was published in the Pinedale Roundup for four successive weekly issues of said paper commencing with its issue of May 27, 1965, and the time stated therein and limited by statute for presenting and filing claims has expired and all claims that have been presented and filed herein have been paid or otherwise disposed of; that all costs, charges and expenses of administration of said estate, including executor's commission and attorney fees, and all taxes levied and assessed against said estate have been paid and discharged; that there is no inheritance tax due from said estate or persons interested therein; that said executor duly returned and filed with the Clerk of this Court a true inventory and appraisal of the estate of said decedent, and that said estate has been fully administered and in condition to be closed and the residue thereof distributed to the persons entitled thereto by the terms of the will of said decedent; and the Court having fully considered the matter and proceedings herein had and the evidence adduced, finds:

That the final account of the executor to be true and correct.

That by the terms of the last Will and Testament of Joseph Huston, deceased, duly admitted to probate herein, he devised and bequeathed his estate as follows:

FIRST: I give and bequeath unto my daughter, Orvene Reed, of Pinedale, Wyoming, all my oil royalties, which shall be paid
