NOW, THEREFORE, THE COURT DOES ORDER, ADJUDGE AND DECREE:

1. That the following described real and personal property be set over to the widow, Mary Subic, as exempt homestead property, subject to the first mortgage and the chattel mortgage, together with the sum of \$200.00 to the State Bank of Big Piney, Big Piney, Wyoming, described as follows, to-wit:

The Lots Numbered Nine (9) and Ten (10), in Block Eleven (11), C. P. MacGlashan's First Addition to the Town of Big Piney, Wyoming, together with all buildings thereon, and any and all other improvements appertaining or belonging thereto.

One frame, steel covered building 30' x 80' located on or near Lots Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8) of Block 4 Original Townsite of Big Piney, Wyoming, and

One electric welder; one air compressor, and all tools, shop equipment and materials and supplies now contained in that certain sheet metal building known as the Big Piney Blacksmith Shop, all household furnishings and attachments now contained in that log and frame dwelling all situated on Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10), Block Eleven (11), C. P. MacGlashan's First Addition to the Town of Big Piney, Wyoming.

2. That the following described motor vehicles be set over to the widow, Mary Subic, as exempt homestead property, to-wit:

One 1960 Oldsmobile Holiday Coupe, Motor No. 607K01855

3. That the Administrator, Francis Tanner, pay to Sievers and Mason, Attorneys at Law, the sum of \$300.00 as attorney's fees and to himself as administrator the sum of \$300.00.

4. That the remaing costs of publication in the amount of \$19.50 be paid.

5. That Sievers and Mason, Attorneys at Law, be paid \$25.05 for expenses incurred during the administration of the estate.

6. That no further administration be had herein unless further and additional estate be discovered.
