

## RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned

Richard Hecox

for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto LOWER VALLEY POWER AND LIGHT, INC., a cooperative corporation, (hereinafter called the Corporation), whose post office address is Afton, Wyoming, and to its successors or assigns, the right to enter upon said lands of the undersigned, situated in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, and more particularly described as follows:

Portion of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 24, Township 37N., Range 110W

and to construct, operate and maintain on the above described lands, an electric transmission and/or distribution line or system, to cut trees located within 20 feet of the centerline of said line or system, or that may interfere with or threaten to endanger said line or system. The centerline of said line or system for which right-of-way is granted is more particularly described as follows:

Location of power line beginning at the Northwest corner of lot 14, thence East paralleling the North property lines of lots 14, 8, 6, 4, and 2 approximately 1010' and also paralleling the East property lines of lots 12 and 11, approximately 300' of the Richard Hecox Homesites area.

The undersigned agrees that all poles, wires and other facilities, installed on the above described lands at the Corporation's expense, shall remain the property of the Corporation, removable at the option of the Corporation.

The grantor reserves the right to cultivate, use and occupy said premises for any purpose consistent with the rights and privileges above granted and which will not interfere with or endanger any of the grantee's poles and facilities therein or use thereof. In case of the permanent abandonment of said right-of-way, title and interests herein granted shall end, cease and determine.

The work of installing said electric transmission or distribution line or system shall be done with care, and all damage to the premises caused thereby shall be repaired at the expense of the Corporation.
