THE COURT FINDS from the files and records herein, and supporting evidence, generally, that the allegations of the Petition for Distribution filed herein are true and the prayer should be granted, and that Agnes A. Gottschalk had retained her legal residence in Laramie, Albany County, Wyoming wherein she left an Estate of real and personal property when she died at Tarpon Springs, Florida, on or about July 12, 1966, leaving her two daughters, Helen G. Fernald of Tarpon Springs, Florida, and Joan G. Rooney of San Francisco, California, as her sole and only next of kin and heirs at law and sole legatees and devisees under her Last Will and Testament dated January 7, 1946 which was admitted to probate by the Order entered herein on October 12, 1966; that on said daughters' Petition David N. Hitchcock was appointed Administrator with the Will Annexed of said Estate, both Executors named in the Will being deceased, and he received Letters of Administration and commenced administration of the Estate on October 12, 1966, in the Laramie Daily Boomerang published Notice to Creditors on October 15, 22 and 29, 1966, and Notice of Final Settlement on July 19 and 26, and August 2 and 9, 1967; that the Administrator has paid all expenses of funeral and last illness which were the only claims filed by creditors within the time allowed by law, paid and settled the inheritance tax due the State of Wyoming, filed his Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate and his First and Final Account and Supplemental Account showing that the total amount accounted for is the sum of \$25,447.58 upon which the Administrator's statutory commission is the sum of \$858.83, and has filed application for payment of any sums which may be due the Estate from the U. S. Social Security Administration
