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5. Grantor reserves the right to use said roadway for any purpose consistent with the rights and privileges herein granted and which will not interfere with or obstruct the full use and enjoyment of said roadway by the United States, its assigns, or by the people of the United States generally.

6. No Member or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this contract or to any benefit that may arise herefrom, but this restriction shall not be construed to extend to this contract if made with a corporation or company for its general benefit.

7. It is further mutually agreed that the use of said roadway will be subject to the following special conditions:

That the United States will fence the boundaries of the easement herein granted on both sides with a standard 4-strand barbed wire fence, and erecting a sign at the beginning of the right-of-way as follows: "This access granted by Vernon A. Mrak. Please respect private property".
