

pole or fence enclosure and to construct thereon such sanitation and other facilities as GRANTEE may desire. The GRANTEE shall have the right to construct the foregoing roadways, and thereafter shall maintain the same.

3. The right of GRANTEE to hereafter plant, from time to time as desired by GRANTEE, willows at such places on the bed and banks of the river traversing the lands described in Paragraph One (1) for purposes of controlling water-action erosion and improving the fishery, and to erect such short stretches of fences as may be desired in protecting said plantings against livestock; and to perform such other work from time to time as desired by GRANTEE within the beds and banks of said stream for purposes of improving the fishery on said lands. GRANTEE further being hereby given the right to enter from time to time said lands for purposes of stocking the waters thereon with game fish. GRANTEE's actions pursuant to this paragraph shall not, however, unreasonably conflict with GRANTOR's retained rights in and to the subject land and water.

4. GRANTOR further agrees that upon acceptance of this contract by the GRANTEE that it will not remove any brush, willows or other vegetation other than noxious weeds from within twenty-five (25) feet of the Green River on the lands above described for as long as the easements herein granted remain in force and effect except upon express written permission of the GRANTEE; and it is further agreed that the channel shall not be changed or altered in any way by the GRANTOR or anyone working under the GRANTOR, except upon express written permission of the GRANTEE.

5. GRANTOR hereby agrees for the duration of the easements herein contained to restrict and control the utilization of all herbicides, insecticides, or other chemicals on said premises so that their use will in no way harm, endanger or interfere with the fishery on said lands.

6. GRANTOR further agrees during the duration of the easements herein contained to minimize the removal of willows, trees, brushes or other vegetation from along the banks of the Green River upon the premises herein described.

7. In the event the Wyoming Game and Fish Commission ever abandons, gives up, disposes of, or relinquishes this easement, either voluntarily or involuntarily, or uses, or authorizes use of, this easement for camping, hunting or any other purpose not specifically set forth herein, said easement shall be automatically extinguished and obliterated and the land shall return to the condition the land
