GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR FARSON-PINEDALE ROAD

TO

WYOMING STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

Examined authority vested in it by and under the Constitution of the State of Wyoming and the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, doth, for and in consideration of the payment of TWO HUNDRED THIRTEEN AND 00/100 DOLLARS

(\$ 213.00) grant to WYOMING STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

for the uses and purposes and upon the conditions hereinafter set forth, an easement for FARSON-PINEDALE ROAD

over a certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land for the Farson-Pinedale Road Two Hundred Feet (200') in width, being One Hundred Feet (100') on each side of a center line across the West Half West Half ($\frac{W_2}{2}W_2$) Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range One Hundred Seven (107) West of the 6th P. M. in Sublette County, Wyoming, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south boundary of said Section 36 from which the southwest corner thereof bears S. $88^{\circ} 47'$ W. a distance of 488.3 feet; thence N. $3^{\circ} 55'$ W. a distance of 2,831.5 feet to the point of beginning of a $1^{\circ} 00'$ circular curve to the left the radius of which is 5,729.6 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of $18^{\circ} 02.2'$ a distance of 1,803.7 feet, more or less, to a point on the west boundary of said Section 36 from which the west quarter corner thereof bears S. $1^{\circ} 29'$ E. a distance of 1950.0 feet.

Said parcel of land containing 21.3 acres, more or less.
