

3. The right to use the road to serve the Grantor's property to the extent permitted by the rules and regulations of the Secretary as the same may be amended, in such manner as not unreasonably to interfere with its use by the United States, its authorized users or assigns, or cause substantial injury thereto.

Provided, however, that if for a period of five (5) years the Grantee shall cease to use the road, or parts thereof, for the purposes granted, or shall abandon the same, then, in any such events, the premises traversed thereby shall be freed from said easement, or parts thereof, as fully and completely as if this deed had not been made. In the event of such nonuse for the period stated, the Regional Forester shall furnish to the Grantor a statement in recordable form evidencing such nonuse.
