

AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF WYOMING }
County of Sublette } ss.

Betty D. Harrison, of said county and state, being first
duly sworn on her oath, says:

That she is the surviving widow of George B. Harrison aka
George Bissell Harrison, deceased, who died June 1, 1969, in
Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

That on the 29th day of June 1953, Jesse Baldwin, sometimes
known as Jess Baldwin, and Nora Baldwin, husband and wife,
conveyed by Warranty Deed certain real property, situated in
Sublette County, State of Wyoming, to George B. Harrison and
Betty D. Harrison, husband and wife, as Tenants of an Estate
by the Entireties and not as Tenants in Common, described as
follows, to-wit:

Lots 12 and 13 and 14 in Block 3 of the Townsite of
Shelter Park as the same appear on the Plat and Map
thereof of record in the office of the County Clerk
and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sublette County,
Wyoming, together with all improvements situate
thereon or appurtenant thereto.

That said Warranty Deed was duly recorded and filed for
record in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register
of Deeds, Sublette County, Wyoming, on the 13th day of July,
1953, and recorded in Book 7 of Deeds, page 339.

That the deceased, George B. Harrison aka George Bissell
Harrison is one and the same person as the said George B.
Harrison, one of the grantees in the before mentioned Warranty
Deed; that the affiant, Betty D. Harrison, is one and the same
person as the Betty D. Harrison, the other grantee in said
Warranty Deed.

That on the 29th day of June, 1953, and many years before
that date, and until his demise, the said George B. Harrison
aka George Bissell Harrison and the said Betty D. Harrison,
were husband and wife, and that the before mentioned Warranty
Deed created an estate by the entireties, under the laws and
the Supreme Court decisions of the State of Wyoming, and at the
