DECREE OF FINAL SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNT
 AND ORDER OF DISTRIBUTION

PAULINE WILLOUGHBY, Administratrix of the Estate of FELIX SIMON, JR., also known as FELIX SIMON, having heretofore rendered and filed herein a full account and report of her administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed a petition for the distribution of the residue of said estate;

And said account and petition coming on this day regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that notice of settlement of said account and the hearing of said petition has been given in the manner and for the time in such cases required by law; and the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds:

1. That said account is in all respects true and correct, and that all claims and debts against said deceased, all taxes against said estate, and all debts, expenses, inheritance taxes and charges of administration, except those items hereinafter specified and set forth, having been fully paid and discharged and that said estate is not ready for distribution and in condition to be closed.

2. That FELIX SIMON, JR. died intestate on the 17th day of August, 1969, at Sublette County, Wyoming, being at that time a resident of Rock Springs, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, and that said deceased left estate in Sweetwater and Sublette Counties, Wyoming, consisting of real and personal property.

3. That PAULINE WILLOUGHBY filed her Petition in this Court on the 15th day of December, 1969, to be appointed as administratrix of the estate of said deceased, and that Letters of Administration were issued to the petitioner by the Clerk of this Court on the 18th day of December, 1969.

4. That on December 31, 1969, January 7 and 14, 1970, said petitioner duly published Notice to Creditors of said deceased to present their claims in the manner prescribed by law; and that more than three [3] months have elapsed since the first publication of said Notice to Creditors.

5. That on the 20th day of January, 1970, said petitioner made and returned to this Court a true Inventory and Appraisement of all of the estate of said deceased which had come into her possession and knowledge.
