

thence along said 6° 00' circular curve to the right through a central angle of 5° 22' a distance of 94.0 feet to the end of said curve; thence N. 2° 41' E. a distance of 2976.8 feet to the point of beginning of a 3° 00' circular curve to the left; thence along said 3° 00' circular curve to the left, through a central angle of 13° 38' a distance of 454.4 feet to the end of said curve; thence N. 10° 57' W. a distance of 1728.1 feet to the point of beginning of a 2° 00' circular curve to the right; thence along said 2° 00' circular curve to the right through a central angle of 1° 59' a distance of 98.8 feet to a point on the north boundary of said Section 22, from which the northeast corner thereof bears N. 89° 51' E. a distance of 312 feet; thence continuing along said 2° 00' circular curve to the right through a central angle of 7° 17' a distance of 364.5 feet to the point of ending of said curve; thence N. 1° 41' W. a distance of 689.3 feet to the point of beginning of a 2° 00' circular curve to the left; thence along said 2° 00' circular curve to the left through a central angle of 11° 28' a distance of 573.3 feet to the point of ending of said curve; thence N. 13° 09' W. a distance of 2482.2 feet to the point of beginning of a 2° 00' circular curve to the right; thence along said 2° 00' circular curve to the right through a central angle of 10° 14' a distance of 511.7 feet to the end of said curve; thence N. 2° 55' W. a distance of 750.4 feet to a point on the north boundary of said Section 15, from which the northeast corner thereof bears N. 89° 40' E. a distance of 1069 feet.

Excepting and excluding from the above described abandonment (1) a Right of Way Grant across U. S. Government land dated November 21, 1969 and recorded June 30, 1971 on Page 464 of Book 27 of Miscellaneous, (2) a Warranty Deed dated November 20, 1969 and recorded January 21, 1970 on Page 499 of Book 14 of Deeds.

Said parcels of land abandoned by this action containing 11.0 acres, more or less.


