The above cause came on regularly for hearing on the 9th day of October, 1971, before the Honorable C. Stuart Brown, Judge of the District Court, and the plaintiffs appearing by their attorney, Gerald R. Mason, and the defendants having not appeared except through the appearance of John S. Mackey, court appointed guardian ad litem for the incompetent and minor defendants herein and for any of the said defendants which may be serving with the armed forces of the United States or its allies, and the Court having examined the service of process and being now fully advised in the premises finds:

That the plaintiffs' Complaint was filed in this Court on the 30th day of July, 1971, and Summons duly issued out of and under the seal of this Court.

That Summons was duly issued for service upon the defendants, and each of them, on the 30th day of July, 1971, and served upon R. E. Clark by Alias Summons the 9th day of August, 1971, by John Reed III, Deputy Sheriff of Lincoln County. Summons on the other defendants, and each of them, was returned not served for the reason that the other defendants, none of them, could be found within Sublette County, Wyoming.

That service upon the defendants, and each of them, was made by publication in the Pinedale Roundup, a qualified newspaper published at Pinedale, Wyoming, as more particularly
