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That service of process was had upon the defendant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation by serving a Summons upon Ellen Reck, personally and in person for C. T. Corporation System, agent for service of process for Amerada Petroleum Corporation, and it has filed an answer herein disclaiming any interest.

That service upon the remaining defendants, and each of them, was made by publication in the Pinedale Roundup, a qualified newspaper published at Pinedale, Wyoming, as more particularly appears from the affidavit of publication heretofore filed herein.

That after the first publication of said notice, affiant caused to be delivered to the Clerk of the above Court, a sufficient number of copies of said publication for mailing to each of said defendants whose place of residence was known to affiant and caused said clerk to mail by registered mail with return receipt requested a copy of said publication addressed to each defendant at the last known place of residence shown and stated in said publication.

That as to each of said defendants not answering, their present addresses and places of residence remain unknown to affiant and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained.

That the unknown heirs and devisees of any of the above named individual defendants who may be deceased are unknown and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained.

That it is not known whether or not any of the above named defendants are in the military services of the United States or serving with the forces of any nation with which the United States may be allied.

That cause is one of the actions mentioned in Rule 4 F, Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure, in that it is an action brought by plaintiffs for the purpose of obtaining a decree declaring, determining and establishing the rights and interests of the plaintiffs and each and all of the defendants in certain real property, hereinafter described, and quieting title and interests of the plaintiffs as established against the claims
