

The decedent, Thomas E. O'Brien, died testate on the 4th day of March, 1971 and was at the time of his death a resident of the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming and by the terms of his said will, the decedent did give, devise and bequeath all of his estate unto Helen L. O'Brien and Shirley Payne Setzler, sisters, who are entitled to the residue of estate in the hands of the administratrix;

NOW THEREFORE upon the motion of John S. Mackey, as attorney for the administratrix, and no objections thereto being made, THE COURT DOES

ORDER, ADJUDGE AND DECREE that the said final account of Helen L. O'Brien, administratrix as aforesaid, be, and the same is hereby settled, allowed and approved and that the residue of said estate hereinafter particularly described, and any other property not now known or discovered, which may belong to the said estate or in which said estate may have any interest, be, and the same is hereby distributed unto Helen L. O'Brien and Shirley Payne Setzler, sisters of the decedent, equally and in equal shares;

The following constitutes a particular description of the residue of said estate referred to in this decree, and of which distribution is now ordered as aforesaid, to-wit:

Section 35 - N/2
