

PROCEEDINGS TO DETERMINE HEIRSHIP ()
TO LAND OF JEREMIAH COLLINS, () JUDGMENT DETERMINING HEIRSHIP
Deceased. () AND INTEREST IN LAND

This matter having come on regularly for hearing upon the petition of Robert W. Sievers, Sievers and Mason, Attorneys at Law, Pinedale, Wyoming on behalf of Jeremiah Collins Hege and Edwin Collins Hege, and the Court having determined that notice having been given as required by law; that no one having appeared in opposition to said petition; that documentary evidence having been offered and received in evidence; and the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. Jeremiah Collins died, testate, in Washington, D. C. January 30, 1954, and at the time of his death, was the owner, in fee simple, of the following described real property situated in Sublette County, Wyoming and described as follows, to-wit:

Township 58 North, Range 110 West, 6th P. M.
Section 12; E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Township 59 North, Range 110 West, 6th P. M.
Section 28; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Containing 160 acres, more or less.

2. That the original will of Jeremiah Collins was admitted to probate on February 9, 1954 in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia; that at the time of the demise of Jeremiah Collins, Lena Collins Hege, daughter, and Ted E. Collins, son, were the sole heirs at law of Jeremiah Collins and also sole residual beneficiaries under above cited will.

3. That Lena Collins Hege died, testate July 31, 1951, at Washington, D. C., being a widow at the time of her death and leaving as her sole heirs at law and also sole residual legatees of her will, duly probated in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, Edwin Collins Hege and Jeremiah Collins Hege, your petitioners herein.
