

4. That Ted E. Collins, aka Timothy Edward Collins, died testate July 31, 1956, leaving his widow Frances Parker Collins as his sole heir and residual legatee of his will duly probated in the District Court of the First Judicial District of the State of Montana in and for the County of Lewis and Clark; that Frances Parker Collins aka Frances P. Collins, died in 1968 being a widow, leaving as her sole heir and residual legatee Margaret W. Chivers of Helena, Montana, according to her will duly probated in the District Court of the First Judicial District of the State of Montana, in and for the County of Lewis and Clark.

5. That there has been no previous record judicial determination of the right of descent of said real property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That Jeremiah Collins died January 30, 1934.

2. That Lena Collins Hege was a daughter and Ted E. Collins was a son of Jeremiah Collins, and, as such, were heirs of said Jeremiah Collins; that by will of Jeremiah Collins, deceased, duly probated in the United States District Court of the District of Columbia, and as heirs aforesaid, an undivided one-half ($1/2$) interest each in the hereinafter described real property descended to them, described as follows, to-wit:

Township 38 North, Range 110 West, 6th P. M.
Section 12; $E\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13; $SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$
Township 39 North, Range 110 West, 6th P. M.
Section 28; $NE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$
Containing 160 acres, more or less.

3. That Jeremiah Collins Hege and Edwin Collins Hege are sons and sole heirs and residual legatees under the will of Lena Collins Hege, deceased, and, as such, an undivided one-half ($1/2$) interest each (an undivided one-quarter ($1/4$) interest in the whole) of the undivided one-half ($1/2$) interest which descended to Lena Collins Hege, descended to them and consequently said Jeremiah Collins Hege and Edwin Collins Hege are the owners of an undivided one-fourth ($1/4$) interest each in
