JUDGMENT AND DECREE

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing before the Court this day, and the Plaintiff being present in person and by her attorney, N. Randolph Reese, and the Defendant having filed herein his Appearance, Waiver of Issuance and Service of Process upon himself and consenting that the Court hear and determine the issues without further notice to him and this matter, having come on further to be heard, the Court finds:

1.
