THIS AGREEMENT, Entered into this the 21st day of July, A. D. 1937, between CHARLES J. BAYER, also known as CHARLES BAYER, and MARGARET C. BAYER, his wife, of Pinedale, Wyoming, hereinafter called lessor, and THE CALIFORNIA COMPANY, a California corporation, hereinafter called lessee, does witness:

1. That lessor, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN and no/100ths---Dollars (\$10.00) in hand paid, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained to be performed by the lessee, has this day granted and leased and hereby grants, leases and lets unto the lessee for the purpose of mining and operating for and producing oil and gas, casinghead gas and casinghead gasoline, laying pipe lines, building tanks, storing oil, building powers stations, telephone lines and other structures thereon to produce save, take care of and manufacture all of such substances, and for housing and boarding employees, the following described tract of land in Sublette County, Wyoming, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SENW $\frac{1}{4}$), Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), and Lot Four (4) of Section Seven (7); Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), and Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18); West Half of the Northeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19); Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Nine (29); East Half of the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirty (30) and Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30); Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-one (31); Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32); All in Township Thirty-four North (T.34N.), Range One Hundred Nine West (R.109W.); Excepting that portion of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19); Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range One Hundred Nine (109) West described as follows:
Beginning at the Southwest (SW) Corner of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter; thence north 0°2' West 1533.37 feet; thence south 0°50' east 1548.68 feet; thence south 89°55' west 212.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.73 acres more or less. CJB
