TO HAVE AND TO HOLD with all the rights and privileges as conveyed to VIRGINIA HENSON in that certain oil and gas the assignment thereto.

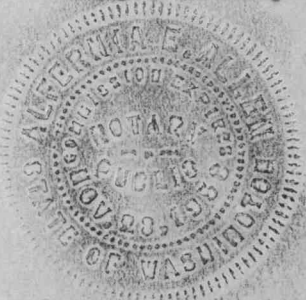
