

ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, three-fourths (3/4) undivided interest in said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by J. H. Morgan and C. I. Justheim.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned Assignors, the present owners of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Arthur B. Belfer all their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owners of three-fourths (3/4) undivided interest in and to said lease and rights thereunder, subject to one-sixteenth (1/16) overriding royalty payable to Superior Oil Company, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith and to his heirs, successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned Assignors for their heirs, successors and representatives, do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns that they are the lawful owners of the said lease and rights and interest thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid; and that the undersigned will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
