

A tract of land conveyed to M. M. Baker, March 3, 1931, described as follows: Beg- 263
inning on a point which is 666 feet South of a point which is 1373 feet East of the
Northwest corner of Section Two (2), Township Thirty Three (33) North, Range One
Hundred Eleven (111) West (the said initial point being 140 feet North of the North-
east corner of a tract of land owned by E. D. Key) and running thence East 280 feet;
thence South 140 feet; thence West 280 feet; thence North 140 feet to the point of

A tract of land conveyed to Blackmon and Son July 15, 1930, described as follows:
Beginning on a point which is 1106 feet South of a point which is 1373 feet East
of the Northwest corner of Section Two (2), Township Thirty Three (33) North, Range
One Hundred Eleven (111) West (the said initial point being 300 feet South of the
Northwest corner of a tract of land owned by E. D. Key) and running thence East 200
feet; thence South 50 feet; thence West 200 feet; thence North 50 feet, to the
point of beginning:
