That he is a citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years.

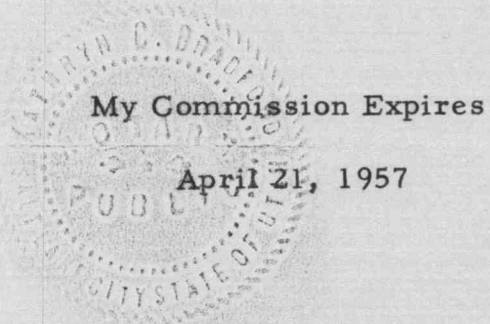
That since 1940 this affiant has been interested in and directly
